Alternatively, if students wish to improve their English Language, SOAS offers tailor-made courses on the <u>International Summer Programme (with English Language)</u>. These courses combine academic study and English development in an interactive way and provide a great introduction to studying at an English speaking university.

Students coming from your institution to SOAS for the first time are entitled to **10% off of their summer tuition fees.** Upon completion of the Summer School, students will also gain access to **20% off future programmes*** they study with us the following year.
